

PROCLAMATION

Alberta Police and Peace Officers' Memorial Day

September 28, 2025

WHEREAS: This event is an occasion to remember the police and peace officers who have fallen in the line of duty, and also recognizes families, friends and colleagues who have suffered the devastating loss of a loved one. The ceremony includes speeches from dignitaries and a reading of the names of Alberta's fallen officers; and

WHEREAS: The Pillar of Strength is a permanent monument at the south grounds of the Alberta legislature. It symbolizes Alberta's commitment to the peace officer community and recognizes the ultimate sacrifices made by fallen officers; and

WHEREAS: At the annual Police and Peace Officers' Memorial Day in 2024 we honoured the 106 police and peace officers who have died in the line of duty in Alberta since 1876;

THEREFORE: I, Mayor Simon Boersma, do hereby declare September 28th, 2025, as **Alberta Police and Peace Officers' Memorial Day**, in the Town of Morinville.
